HISTORIC HOME TO BE RELOCATED

Davie's historic Walsh/Osterhoudt Home is on the move this weekend.

The 1925 home, which currently sits at 6890 Griffin Rd., will be moved to the Old Davie School site to make room for Lakeside Village at Davie, a new housing and retail development.

To celebrate the move, Lakeside Village's developer, Jordan Klemow, invites all residents to a free brunch at the old house site from 10 a.m. to noon Saturday. Residents can see the house in its original setting for the last time and learn about the move, which Klemow is financing.

The two-story house has been placed on a wheeled flatbed and will be towed south across a cow pasture, then east to the canal that borders the school site. When the three-day move is complete, the house will host exhibits and be incorporated into historical tours, said Constance Savory, the Old Davie School's executive director.
